Artwork that is displayed in the show and any remaining unselected artwork, must be picked up on Monday, June 24 from 4 - 7pm. All unclaimed artwork will be charged a \$10/day/piece handling fee.

If someone other than the artist is to pick up the artwork, please provide him/her with the receipt or a signed letter of permission.

2019 Juror: Michael Boss

Michael is an artist and educator living in Winnipeg, Manitoba. His artwork ranges from drawing and painting to photography, sculpture, installation, performance and writing. His work has been exhibited in solo and group exhibitions across Canada, in the United States, Australia, Germany and Ukraine. Michael held the position of Assistant Professor of Fine Art at Mount Allison University and Lakehead University. He has also taught art at other post secondary institutions in Manitoba and Ontario. He was Head of Education at The Art Gallery of Southwestern Manitoba in Brandon for 7 years and was Head of Studio Programs at The Winnipeg Art Gallery from 1998-2014.

General Rules:

1. Each artist who is a resident of Manitoba (residing therein for at least 6 months) may submit up to four (4) works. The juror will select the works to be hung and his or her decision is final.
2. An entry fee of \$5.00 per piece will be charged and will be payable to the Association upon delivery of the work for consideration by the juror.
3. **All works must be original, unaided work of the artist. Copies will not be considered.**
4. Accepted artworks must have been completed in the last two years.
5. You will be notified by email if your art has been accepted.
6. **Two dimensional works must be labelled, suitably framed or presented with wire and ready for hanging. Framing systems with only glass, a backing and clips are not acceptable. Charcoal, pastel, watercolour or pencil works must be protected under glass or plexi. All work is to be no larger than 32" x 40" when framed.**
7. Sculpture and mixed media works are restricted to a 36" cube and may weigh no more than 40 lbs. If special display is required, the artist must provide this.
8. A label with the artist's name, address and phone number, picture title and price, must be firmly attached to the back of each art piece (or the bottom of a sculpture). (See attached label forms.)
9. No repeat artworks will be accepted.
10. No WET artworks will be accepted.
11. The Red River Exhibition will retain a 20% fee for the sale of art works and artists are advised to price their work accordingly. (Upwards to 200,000 people may view the works over the course of the show.) Works must be marked NFS if they are NOT offered for purchase.
12. Submission of entries implies acceptance of all rules of the competition. All entries must be accompanied by fully completed and signed entry forms and fees.
13. **The Exhibition assumes no responsibility for loss, damage or injury of any kind and however caused to any exhibit or exhibitor.**
14. Prize winning entrants, and/or guardians of entrants, consent to the use of each participant's name and photo in any public recognition. The Exhibition reserves the right to reproduce any entries for publicity related to this contest unless otherwise stated.

Categories:

This is an Open competition. First, second and third place will be awarded in each of the following categories. One Best in Show award will be presented.

Painting: Watercolours, oils, acrylics or mixed media generally presented in a frame and ready for hanging

Drawings: Pencil, coloured pencil, pastels, pen and ink, charcoal, etc. generally matted and framed and ready for hanging

Mixed Media: Items such as artist prints (no giclees), textiles, cartoons, scratchboard, air brush, computer generated images other than digital photographs, collage, or combinations of more than three media

Sculpture: Artist's choice of medium, may be stone, wood, clay, ceramic, etc. (see rule 7 for size and weight restrictions)

Teen: For artists 13 to 19 years of age (works may be submitted for judging unframed but if selected must be framed for display.) Should a Teen wish to enter the main categories above and not as a teen, they may do so. If a Teen wishes to enter both the main categories AND the Teen category, they must enter different pieces in each.
