Accessible Services

There are pathways and ramps throughout the Park to assist with wheelchair access. All public buildings at the Park are accessible.

ATMS

ATMs are located in front of Exhibition Place.

Baby Change Stations

Baby change stations are located in all public washrooms.

Lost Kids' Centre

The Red River Ex is pleased to offer child safety services while at the Park. The Lost Kids' Centre booth is located inside the east entrance. Our volunteers are pleased tag your child with your cell phone number upon entering the Park. Or simply call the Lost Kids' Centre for information. All security guards can be contacted regarding any lost child at the Park.

Medical Services

Medical services are provided and can be accessed at the Park. Please visit the medical services trailer next to the west entrance for any health concern or medical emergency. Or contact any security guard with a medical issue.

Red River Exhibition Park cannot accommodate guests' pets. Do not leave your pets unattended in your vehicle. Kindly leave your pets at home or make arrangements to house them at a kennel.

Wagons, scooters and wheelchairs are available for rent at the west entrance. Rental prices: Wagons: \$15; Scooters: \$45; Wheelchairs: \$20

Telephones
