

THE FALL FAIR: COVID-19 Health Protocols

Red River Exhibition Park thanks the community for their efforts in minimizing the spread of COVID-19 within our province. Thank you for doing your part to ensure we all stay safe.

We must all abide by the province's health orders. Please read the following safety information.

What safety measures are in place to help keep everyone safe?

The safety of everyone at Red River Exhibition Park is our top priority. We remain in contact with Manitoba Public Health to ensure everyone stays safe. Before you visit The Fall Fair remember:

- All guests 12 years and older must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19.
- Proof of vaccination (either a physical card or a digital QR code) is required for entry, plus one piece of government issued ID.
- Children under 12 years old may attend when accompanied by a fully vaccinated adult.
- All events will take place outdoors. All indoor facilities, with the exception of washroom buildings, are closed.
- Masks are required when entering indoor washroom facilities and recommended outdoors when physical distancing cannot be maintained.
- Capacity around the Park will be managed and limited.
- Red River Exhibition Park has two monitored points of entry. One on the east side and one on the west side.
- Tickets may be purchased in advance (online or from local retailers) in order to ensure fewer lineups at each entrance gate.

Do I need to be vaccinated to attend?

Yes. All guests 12 years and older must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 to be permitted entry into the Park. Proof of vaccination (physical card or digital QR code) is required for entry, plus one piece of government issued ID. Children under the age of 12 may attend when accompanied by a fully vaccinated adult.

Will capacity be limited and physical distancing encouraged?

Yes. There is 200 acres of space at Red River Exhibition Park. There is plenty of outdoor space to social distance. All picnic tables will be spaced out to allow for ample room at stages and attraction areas. We ask that guests do their part to ensure physical distancing is maintained.

Can I attend if I'm visiting from outside of Manitoba?

Yes. Guests from outside of Manitoba are welcome to attend. Visiting guests must adhere to all Manitoba public health orders. Proof of vaccination will be required from out-of-province guests 12 years and older for entry into Red River Exhibition Park.

Can my child who is under 12 and not vaccinated attend?

Children under 12 years old are welcome as long as the adult or adults they are with are fully vaccinated.

Will rides be cleaned between guests?

Yes. Precautions are being taken by the midway companies to ensure that all rides are frequently cleaned and sanitized. This may result in longer wait times. Thank you, in advance for your patience.

Will there be hand sanitizer and hand washing stations available?

Yes. Hand sanitizer, hand wash stations and washroom facilities are all available for guests to clean and wash their hands. Remember, masks must be worn when entering washroom buildings.

Is water available?

Please bring or purchase your own water as water fountains are not available.

What rides are coming?

The midway you are used to experiencing during the Red River Ex is traveling elsewhere and is not able to stop in Winnipeg. We are pleased to partner with Manitoba carnival companies: Select Shows and Canuck Amusements.
