Maintaining healthy standards and practices inside and outside our buildings, facilities and premises at Red River Exhibition Park remains our key focus. As we move closer to the Red River Ex this summer, we're committed to ensuring a safe, enjoyable and memorable experience for all our visitors. We're taking the following measures:

- Frequent disinfection of hard surfaces (door handles, tables, ATMs)

- As per the current Public Health directive, visitors to the Red River Ex are no longer required to be fully vaccinated.
